You can help protect the environment by bringing the harmful wastes you have around your home to the collection site to keep them out of the regular trash and landfill. The collection site will accept...

- Household cleaners, such as drain, oven and metal cleaners; polishes; and disinfectants.
- Paint, thinner, stripper, adhesives, and other home improvement products.
- Herbicides, pesticides, fungicides, and similar lawn and garden products.
- Waste oil, antifreeze, oil and fuel additives, body putty, refrigerants, and other automotive products.
- Tires, batteries, pool chemicals, medicines, aerosols and compressed gas, fingernail polish remover, and other miscellaneous wastes.

We cannot accept:

- Medical wastes
- Radioactive wastes
- Explosives
- Commercial wastes

Keep wastes in original containers.
Do not mix chemicals.
100 lb. limit per family.
